

**MINUTES of the meeting of the GRASSMOOR, HASLAND AND WINSICK PARISH  
COUNCIL held on 12 October 2005 at the Grassmoor Community Centre.**

**PRESENT**

Three members of the public attended the public participation session.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Three members of the public attended the meeting to express concern over the increasing levels of nuisance and anti-social behaviour being occurring on North Wingfield Road. This was particularly worrying as the Dispersal Order was due to expire in the near future. The Clerk had already highlighted the problems to Inspector Durham but agreed to do so again. Should the problems persist there was a possibility that another Dispersal Order could be obtained.

**POLICE/PARISH LIAISON**

PC Kerry Gough-McMillan attended the meeting to update the Parish Council on crimes committed in the area since the last meeting. It was pleasing that there had been very few crimes committed recently.

Richard Siddall had been appointed as the Beat Officer for Grassmoor and he would be taking up his duties in the near future. The Chairman and Clerk along with PC Gough-McMillan would meet with PC Siddall in the near future.

**158. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Councillors A H Booker, C J Clarke, R W Marriott and D Rowland.

**159. DECLARATION OF MEMBERS INTERESTS**

Councillor Mrs E A Hill declared a prejudicial interest in the item relating to Planning Matters (Minute No.169) and Councillor M Dovinson declared a prejudicial interest in the item relating to the resignation of the Handyperson (Minute No. 164). Both withdrew from the meeting and took no part in the discussion and voting on the respective items.

**160. MINUTES RESOLVED that the Minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council held on 14 September 2005 be confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.**

**161. ITEMS IN EXCLUSION**

There were no items to be taken in exclusion.

**162. CHAIRMAN'S ANNOUNCEMENTS**

The Chairman was pleased to welcome Councillor Marie Dovinson to her first meeting of the Parish Council.

**163. GRASSMOOR COMMUNITY CENTRE**

There were no matters to report relating to the Community Centre.

**164. RESIGNATION OF PARISH COUNCIL HANDYPERSON**

The Clerk reported that Keith Hemsley had indicated he was resigning from his position as Parish Council Handyman with effect from 31 October 2005. Matthew Dovinson had indicated that he would be willing to take on the additional hours. It was agreed that Matthew be employed as the Parish Council Streetcleaner/Handyman for 26 hours per week with effect from 1 November 2005.

**RESOLVED** that Matthew Dovinson be employed as the Parish Council Streetcleaner/Handyman for 26 hours per week with effect from 1 November 2005.

**165. UPDATE ON GRASSMOOR LAGOONS**

The Clerk reported that he had not received any further information on the position regarding the Lagoons. The Chairman reported that there was a Liaison meeting in the near future at which further information may be forthcoming.

**RESOLVED** that the report be noted.

**166. MILL LANE ALLOTMENTS**

Councillors Garbutt and Barlow presented an update on the situation regarding Mill Lane Allotments. Both were pleased to report that the condition of the Allotments had improved since the last site visit. It was clear that there was a good spirit between the allotment holders and that the majority were working together to improve the site in general. Efforts had been made to ascertain who was renting the majority of plots, although 3 or 4 plot holders were still not known. The majority of plots were now numbered.

It was reported that the Parish Council had been asked to agree to the Pigeon Club being permitted to putting a portacabin on the site to use as a store. It was agreed that no objections be raised provided that the Club agreed to maintain it in a good condition and remove it from the site should they no longer have use for it.

**RESOLVED** that (a) the report be noted; and

(b) permission be granted for the Pigeon Club to erect a portacabin on the site on the condition that it is maintained in a neat and tidy condition and that it is removed from the site if it is no longer required.

**167. CHANGE OF LICENCE – MINERS ARMS, GRASSMOOR**

The Clerk reported that a Notice of Transfer of Full Justices Licence for the Miners Arms to David Slone had been received.

**RESOLVED** that the report be noted.

**168. BUS SHELTER**

The Clerk reported that the County Council were prepared to replace the existing bus shelter outside the Boot and Shoe on the basis that the Parish Council agrees to maintain it in the future.

**RESOLVED** that the Parish Council agree to take on responsibility for the repair and maintenance of the new bus shelter to be provided by the County Council outside the Boot and Shoe.
